INTRODUCTION

Sunnyview Bungalow provides support and long-term accommodation for 4 adults with a learning disability. The home is contracted with the Dorset Supporting People Team at Dorset County Council.

The home is tastefully decorated and furnished, providing a relaxed atmosphere which promotes ordinary living. Our aim is to maintain individuality, the promotion of independent living, personal dignity and respect. Service Users are supported to exercise their personal choice in any decision that may affect them.

LOCATION

Sunnyview is an attractive detached property situated in the village of Stalbridge. The bungalow is within easy walking distance of the local shops and amenities although the home does not have its own transport, Service Users are able to use the car from Sandhills, another DRH property in Stalbridge for appointments and outings. Parking is available within Stalbridge Close.



MOVING INTO SUNNYVIEW

If you are interested in living at Sunnyview Bungalow, you will need to contact your Social Worker or the Community Learning Disability Team who will be able to will advise you if care management is appropriate.

Before any decisions can be made about moving into the bungalow, an agreement needs to be made about whether Sunnyview will be the right home for you and also to agree who will be paying for your rent and support. This is usually done following care management assessments by Social Services and Donna Rayner, the Manager of Sunnyview.

Once you have been told in writing that you are able to live at Sunnyview Donna will arrange for a planned admission which will include visits for tea and overnight/weekend stays dependent upon what is best for you.

WHO PAYS FOR THIS?

You can claim help with payment from the local council. This money is known as "Supporting People" money. Donna or Deborah will explain this to you.

The local council will send this money direct to DRH.

DRH will give you a "Support Agreement", which tells you how much your support actually costs.

We can help explain what this Support Agreement means and if you are happy, we will ask you to sign it with your name.



MONITORING

Sunnyview Bungalow is contracted with the Supporting People Team at Dorset County Council. Supporting People monitor the service Sunnyview offers and ensures that the home complies with relevant legislation. The Home Manager is directly accountable to the DRH Chief Executive. Regular monitoring is carried out by the Deputy Chief Executive.

Everyone living at Sunnyview Bungalow has a tenancy agreement with the home's landlord, Signpost Care Partnership. DRH manage the home and the support staff.

Sunnyview Bungalow staff will help you to complete the forms that are required to apply for the costs of your day-to-day support and housing benefit, which will contribute to the cost of your weekly rent.

STAFFING

Donna Rayner is the Home Manager. Donna has many years experience. Some members of the support team are currently studying for NVQ Level 2.



Support is available on a 24-hour basis. There are experienced support staff on duty in the morning and evening. There is also emergency assistance available. When staff are not around you can get help by using the Careline facility installed within the house. This is a box located next to the telephone which by pressing the button will connect you to 24-hour support service who will summon immediate help should you need it. The staff team work together to provide a support package that is tailored to your individual needs. We are committed to ensuring the lives of those living at Sunnyview are varied, stimulating and fulfilling, promoting optimum independence.

ACCOMMODATION & FACILITIES

This spacious home comprises of 4 single bedrooms, a shared bathroom, a shower room and separate toilet. If it is agreed you can live at Sunnyview you are welcome to bring in your own furniture for your bedroom if you wish to do so.

There is a large combined lounge and dining room, which leads out on to a patio and private front garden. Sunnyview Bungalow is furnished in a modern style and the shared space has a television, DVD, Video and hifi system as well as a computer and Web Cam for anyone who wishes to keep in contact with family members.

Service Users choose and are encouraged to take part in all aspects of daily living, both within the home and the community.



HEALTH NEEDS

There is a health centre within close walking distance of the house, offering a choice of general practitioners providing health care on a 24-hour basis. Service Users are encouraged to register with a GP of their own choice. In addition, the staff team have close working relationships with the local Community Learning Disability Team.

DRH is also registered with the Care Quality Commission as a Domiciliary Care Provider, so if you should fall ill and require additional support in the way of personal care, this can be arranged.

MEALS



Meal times are flexible around the activities of the individual. Staff will support you to purchase, prepare and cook your own meals.
